

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# The Gathering The Greeting

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.** 

Grace, mercy and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

#### And also with you

Mother Juliet says some words of welcome and then says: In peace we gather before God who made us, redeemed us and sustains our life together. In our prayer and praise may we know the grace of Jesus Christ, the love of God and the joy of communion in the Holy Spirit. Let us, therefore, come together in worship and thanksgiving.

#### Gospel Reading John 3: 1-5

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to *John.* **Glory to you, O Lord.** 

Now there was a Pharisee named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews. He came to Jesus by night and said to him, 'Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God; for no one can do these signs that you do apart from the presence of God.' Jesus answered him, 'Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above.' Nicodemus said to him, 'How can anyone be born after having grown old? Can one enter a second time into the mother's womb and be born?' Jesus answered, 'Very truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit.

**Sermon** Mother Juliet

#### **Holy Baptism**

Mother Juliet, Ali, Parents and Godparents gather at the font

#### **Presentation**

Mother Juliet addresses the congregation: Faith is the gift of God to God's people. In baptism the Lord is adding to our number those whom he is calling.

People of God, will you welcome Ali and uphold him in his new life in Christ?

All: With the help of God, we will.

Mother Juliet addresses the Parents and Godparents: Parents and Godparents, the Church receives Ali with joy. Today we are trusting God for his growth in faith. Will you pray for him, draw him by your example into the community of faith and walk with him in the way of Christ?

P and GP: With the help of God, we will.

Mother Juliet addresses the Parents and Godparents: In baptism Ali begins his journey in faith. You speak for him today. Will you care for him, and help him to take his place within the life and worship of Christ's Church? P and GP: With the help of God, we will.

#### The Decision

Mother Juliet addresses Parents and Godparents:

In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him.

Therefore I ask:

Do you turn to Christ?

Do you repent of your sins?

Do you renounce evil?

I turn to Christ.

I repent of my sins.

I renounce evil.

#### Signing with the Cross

The sign of the cross is made with oil on Ali's forehead:

Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross. Do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

Fight valiantly as disciples of Christ against sin, the world and the devil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your lives.

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, restore in you the image of his glory, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ. **Amen.** 

The blessed water is poured into the font:

#### **Profession of Faith**

Brothers and sisters, I ask you to profess the faith of the Church.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist? We believe and trust in God the Father.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again? We believe and trust in God the Son.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

We believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit.

This is the faith of the Church.

This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### The Baptism

*Ali*, I baptise you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen**.

May God, who has received you by baptism into the Church, pour upon you the riches of his grace, that within the company of Christ's pilgrim people you may daily be renewed by his anointing Spirit, and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory. **Amen.** 

#### The Welcome

There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism: By one Spirit we are all baptised into one body. Ali we welcome you in the fellowship of faith; we are children of the same heavenly Father; we welcome you.

We welcome Ali as the party return to their seats.

#### **Prayers**

Let us pray to God.

The response is:

God in your mercy

All: Hear our prayer

Merciful Father:

All: Accept these prayers

for the sake of your Son,

our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

### The Liturgy of the Sacrament The Peace

Peace to you from God our heavenly Mother and Father. Peace from Jesus Christ who is our peace. Peace from the Holy Spirit, our life-giver. The peace of the triune God be always with you: **And also with you.** 

#### Preparation of the Table

#### The Eucharistic prayer

The Lord is here

His Spirit is with us.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is right to praise you, Father, Lord of all creation; in your love you made us for yourself.
When we turned away you did not reject us, but came to meet us in your Son.

You embraced us as your children and welcomed us to sit and eat with you.

In Christ you shared our life that we might live in him and he in us.

He opened his arms of love upon the cross and made for all the perfect sacrifice for sin.

On the night he was betrayed, at supper with his friends he took bread, and gave you thanks; he broke it and gave it to them saying:

Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me.

Father, we do this in remembrance of him: his body is the bread of life.

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine, he gave you thanks, and said:

Drink this, all of you: this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins: do this in remembrance of me.

Father, we do this in remembrance of him: his blood is shed for all.

As we proclaim his death and celebrate his rising in glory, send your Holy Spirit that this bread and this wine may be to us the body and blood of your dear Son.

As we eat and drink these holy gifts make us one in Christ, our risen Lord.

With your whole Church throughout the world we offer you this sacrifice of praise and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest.

#### The Lord's Prayer

Let us pray with confidence as our Saviour has taught us:
Our Father, who art in Heaven;
hallowed be Thy name.
thy Kingdom come;
thy will be done,
on Earth as it is in Heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
and lead us not into temptation
but deliver us from evil,
for thine is the Kingdom
the power and the glory,
for ever and ever.
Amen.

#### **Breaking of the Bread**

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ. Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread.

#### **Agnus Dei**

Jesus, Lamb of God, have mercy on us. Jesus, bearer of our sins, have mercy on us. Jesus, redeemer of the world, grant us peace.

#### **Giving of Communion**

God's holy gifts for God's holy people.

Jesus Christ is holy, Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Communion will be brought to you in one kind. Please stay seated in your place whilst we come to you safely – alternatively a prayer can be said at a physical distance with you as we move round the church.

Silence is kept.

Thank you generous God.

Thank you for teaching us with your word.

Thank you for feeding us with bread and wine.

Thank you for the many gifts we have been given.

May we share what we have been given with others. Amen.
